The 38th annual Delaware Arts Festival is scheduled in the streets of downtown Delaware on Saturday, May 14 from 10 am-6 pm and Sunday, May 15 from 10 am-5 pm.

With portions of Sandusky and Winter streets closed to traffic and over 170 vendors and exhibitors scheduled to showcase their wares, the event will be a day of fun for the whole family.

High quality arts and crafts will be available from Ohio exhibitors as well as those from Indiana, Maryland, Michigan, Kentucky, Florida and Pennsylvania. Items will include ceramics, leather, paintings, sculpture, stained glass, folk art, clothing and fiber art, jewelry and more.

The festival also includes a countywide student art show that will be on display at the Delaware County District Library, 84 E. Winter St., a pet parade and dog agility demonstration, an art auction featuring items donated by festival vendors and music from some of central Ohio's most talented bands.
