Applicants will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee on Saturday, March 23 or Sunday, March 24, 2019. Please save the dates. We will contact you via email as soon as possible after the March 9 application deadline, regarding the day and time of your interview. Applicants must be available for an interview on one of the two days

Applicants should bring to the interview:

- 10 presentable examples of their work (sculpted, casted, printed, painted, photographed, video recorded, sewn, welded, carved, digitally coded/rendered/wire-framed, etc. (For 2-D work please bring items matted, mounted, or framed.)
- A book/binder containing your artwork conception sketches, mapping the process how the examples came to fruition.

The portfolios will be held by the Committee until all interviews are completed. Portfolios should be picked up Monday, March 25 or Tuesday, March 26. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decisions via email by Saturday, March 30.

Certificates of Award will be presented at the Delaware Arts Festival on Saturday, May 18, at noon. Winners are expected to attend. The three Scholarship winners' work shown at the interview will be exhibited at the Delaware County District Library in downtown Delaware during June with specific dates to be determined.
